Dear European Alliance for Medical and Biological Engineering & Science (EAMBES) representatives,

***With this email we officially open the call for nominations of candidates for EAMBES 2023 Councillor positions.***



The Council is the driving force in fulfilling the charitable objectives of EAMBES. By standing as a candidate for this election you (and your organization) will take a leading role in supporting Biomedical Engineering in Europe. For this reason, we warmly encourage you to become actively engaged and to stand for election and/or encourage your fellow representatives to do so. If elected, you will act as independent Councillor, not on behalf of your organization.

Councillors normally serve on the EAMBES Council for two years, with possibility for re-election, and are expected to participate in the Annual Council and General Assembly meetings, about three to four other virtual meetings annually, and possible other meetings that will be organized during main BME scientific conferences.

In 2023, we will elect up to three (3) new members in the Council. We are seeking individuals who are motivated and are actively willing to contribute to various EAMBES initiatives throughout the year. Especially, clinical engineering is not yet well represented, and we are still far from balancing gender and diversities, and to have a good representative from colleagues at different stages of their careers in the Council.

Upon election, the new Councillors will be formally invited to attend the EAMBES Council meeting which will be held in Brussels on March 22-23, 2023, with online access when needed.

The Executive Board members are elected by the new Council from amongst the Council members. In 2023, the position of President Elect is to be filled. Other Executive Board members have their current mandates until 2024.
